RESOLUTION NO. 2023-104

AMENDING CHAPTER 465 FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE OF THE CODIFIED RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE GREATER CLEVELAND REGIONAL TRANSIT AUTHORITY

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 1989-176, the Board of Trustees ("Board") of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority ("Authority") codified the resolutions establishing its policies and procedures; and

WHEREAS, the Authority has conducted a review and determined that Chapter 465 Financial Assistance should be amended to streamline the process for applying for grants.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That Code Book Chapter 465 Financial Assistance is hereby amended to read as specified in Attachment A hereto.

Section 2. That the Board of Trustees hereby waives the fourteen-day period provided for in Article XI, Section 2 of the Bylaws.

Section 3. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.

465.01 FEDERAL GRANT APPLICATIONS.

- (a) Federal Grants.
 - (1) The General Manager, Chief Executive Officer may execute and file applications for federal assistance on behalf of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority.
 - (2) The General Manager, Chief Executive Officer may execute and file with its applications, certifications and assurances and other documents the awarding agency may require for a federal assistance grant or cooperating agreement. (Res. 2007-165. Passed 11-20-07.)
- (b) The General Manager, Chief Executive Officer may submit grant applications to the State of Ohio Department of Transportation, to provide for the state's share of the non-federal funds necessary for federal grant

465.04 DOCUMENTS, REPORTS AND INFORMATION.

(a) <u>Information Required by the State of Ohio</u>. The General Manager, Chief Executive Officer may furnish such additional information, assurances or other documentation, execute any and all documents or assurances and make such reports as is necessary and required by the State of Ohio for state grant funds on behalf of the Authority.

(b) Information Required by the United States Government.

- (1) The General Manager, Chief Executive Officer may execute and file assurances or other documents, and furnish such additional information as the awarding federal agencies may require in connection with federal grant applications on behalf of the Authority.
- (2) The General Manager, Chief Executive Officer may set forth and execute affirmative minority business policies in connection with the procurement needs for projects funded by federal grants. (Res. 1993-156. Passed 9-21-93; Res. 2016-69. Passed 8-16-16.)

465.05 ACCEPTANCE AND EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS.

(a) The General Manager, Chief Executive Officer may accept federal funds from awarding federal agencies on behalf of the Authority and expend such funds in accordance with applicable law, regulations and grant agreements. (Res. 2007-165. Passed 11-20-07.)

(b) The General Manager, Chief Executive Officer may accept and receive funds from the State of Ohio and expend the same pursuant to the terms and conditions of corresponding grant contracts with the State of Ohio. (Res. 1992-17. Passed 1-21-92.)

465.06 FUNDS ALLOCATED BY THE NORTHEAST OHIO AREAWIDE COORDINATING AGENCY ("NOACA")

- (a) That the General Manager, Chief Executive Officer is hereby authorized to file applications, as required, and to execute contracts, as required, on behalf of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority with the Northeast Ohio Areawide Coordinating Agency ("NOACA") for financial assistance and capital project programs (including transfer of highway funds) under all NOACA programs.
- (b) That the General Manager, Chief Executive Officer is authorized to execute and file such applications, any assurances or any other documentation required by NOACA under the financial assistance and capital project programs.
- (c) That the General Manager, Chief Executive Officer is authorized to furnish such additional information as NOACA may require.
- (d) That that the authority granted in subsections (a) (c) hereof is conditioned upon an assessment by the General Manger, Chief Executive Officer that (1) any required local match funds are available; (2) the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority is willing to provide the local match amount for any funding awarded to it by NOACA and (3) the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority represents in writing to NOACA that it is willing to provide the local match amount for any funding awarded to it by NOACA.
- (e) That the General Manager, Chief Executive Officer is authorized to accept the funds resulting from the NOACA financial assistance and capital programs.

465.07 PRIVATE GRANTS.

The General Manager, Chief Executive Officer is hereby authorized to borrow or accept grants from private sources in accordance with State law. (Res. 2016-69. Passed 8-16-16.)

465.08 AUTHORITY OF ACTING GENERAL MANAGER, CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER.

In the absence of the General Manager, Chief Executive Officer, the Acting General Manager, Chief Executive Officer of the Authority is hereby authorized to perform any and all of the functions described in this chapter.
