

# Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority Ridership Report – October 2021

### **Summary**

- The COVID-19 pandemic continued to affect ridership
- System ridership in October 2021 was 1.6 million, representing 23% more riders than in October 2020
  - Average fixed route weekday was 29% higher¹
  - Average fixed route Saturday was 9% higher¹
  - Average fixed route Sunday was 20% higher¹



## <u> Motorbus (MB)</u>

Motorbus ridership in October 2021 was 26% higher than in October 2020

- Average weekday was 33% higher¹
- Average Saturday was 11% higher¹
- Average Sunday was 18% lower<sup>1</sup>



### **Red Line (HR)**

Red Line ridership in October 2021 was 19% higher than in October 2020

- Average weekday was 21% higher¹
- Average Saturday was 13% higher¹
- Average Sunday was 29% higher¹



#### Light Rail (LR)

Light Rail ridership in October 2021 was 1% lower than in October 2020

- Average weekday was 5% higher¹
- Average Saturday was 26% lower<sup>1</sup>
  - Note: In October 2020, Light Rail service ran on all
    5 Saturdays. In 2021, only 4 of 5 Saturdays had
    light rail service due to track maintenance.
- Average Sunday was 7% higher¹



#### HealthLine (RB)

HealthLine ridership in October 2021 was 15% higher than in October 2020


- Average weekday was 20% higher¹
- Average Saturday was 2% higher¹
- Average Sunday was 18% higher¹




#### Paratransit (DR)

Paratransit ridership in October 2021 was 28% higher than in October 2020


#### October 2021 System Ridership by Mode




#### System Ridership by Month
