











Project Management (PM) Training Program Pilot Groups



Forty-six (46) leaders across GCRTA completed an internally created Project Management training pilot course based on Federal Transit Administration guidelines.

- The program consists of 3-days, held:
 - Nov. 30 Dec. 2, 2022
 - January 23 25, 2023

Training content was created and delivered by 10 agency leaders from engineering, project management, procurement, operations, facilities, legal, and training & development.



Diesel Emission Reduction Grant (DERG)

- RTA awarded RTA \$1.9M to replace up to six (6) diesel-powered transit buses
- Replacement buses will be powered by Compressed Natural Gas (CNG) and will significantly reduce diesel emissions in Cuyahoga County
- DERG program is supported with federal funding administered by the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) in conjunction with Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT).



Federal Transit Administration(FTA) Rail Vehicle Replacement Program Grant

- New FTA discretionary grant program created in the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA)
- On January 4, 2023, GCRTA submitted request for \$130M for our Rail Car Replacement Program
- FTA to award up to six grants totaling \$600M
- Grant awards to be announced in April 2023



Government Finance Officer's Association (GFOA) 2022 Award For Excellence

"Winners are shining examples of innovation and outstanding financial management."

- Seven (7) winners selected from entries across diverse set of governments and agencies in the U.S. and Canada
- Two (2) Categories:
 - Creative solutions to Common Challenge
 - Exceptionally Well Implemented GFOA Best Practice



Temporary Promotional Programs

- Code Book Section 840.09 authorizes CEO to offer fare incentives or complimentary rides to promote ridership
- Programs may have a duration of up to 60 days
- CEO shall consider economic impact to the Authority
- CEO shall report results of promotional activities to the Board on at least an annual basis

Results of Promotional Programs:

- For 2022 Two programs were conducted:
 - Non-profit entity Passes provided at 50% discount
 - Non-profit entity Passes provided at 50% discount
- Total amount of discounts provided \$7,440
