MEETING NOTICE

Notice is hereby given that the following meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority will take place on Tuesday, May 2, 2023 in the Board Room of the Authority, 1240 West Sixth Street, Cleveland, OH 44113 for consideration of the listed items and such other items that may properly come before the Board and be acted upon. This meeting will be live streamed on RTA's Board Page www.RideRTA.com/board via the meeting date for staff and members of the public. Members of the public may attend in person.

Based on Centers for Disease Control ("CDC") guidance to avoid crowded places where you cannot stay six feet away from others and Ohio Department of Public Health advice regarding congregating and social distancing, as well as RTA's interest in protecting community and employee health and safety, RTA Board Room and Meeting Room 1 capacity is limited to thirty-six (36) people to allow for social distancing. To accommodate members of the public, RTA will limit the number of staff permitted in the Board Room. All persons entering RTA's Main Office Building ("MOB") at 1240 West 6th Street are required to maintain a distance of six feet or more from other individuals who are not members of their family or household.

As a result of a federal court order on April 18, 2022, the CDC's January 29, 2021 order requiring masks on public transportation conveyances and at transportation hubs is no longer in effect. Discussion of Contractor Recommendation

The Hayden Garage Roof Replacement construction contract will be presented at the Operational Planning & Infrastructure Committee meeting on May 2, 2023.

The roof is 27 years old and has been leaking throughout the structure because of deterioration. By removing wet insulation, adding more insulation to bring the building up to code for thermal efficiency, and installing a multi-plied modified roof membrane system with flashing, the project will replace 212,000 square feet of roof.

Staff will request that the Operational, Planning & Infrastructure Committee recommend that the full Board approve awarding the construction contract at its May 16, 2023 meeting.

SUMMARY OF AWARD Hayden Garage Roof Replacement

PROJECT OVERVIEW:

The Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority (GCRTA) has the need to replace the roof on the Hayden District Bus Garage. This roof is over 25 years old and has passed its intended lifespan. There are signs of wear such as leaks, wet insulation, and delaminated membranes. A new roof eliminates these problems and improves the heating and cooling efficiency of the entire building. The new roof comes with a 30-year NDL (No Dollar Limit) manufacturer's warranty, which includes annual inspections during the warranty period.

PROCUREMENT OVERVIEW:

The Invitation for Bid ("IFB") for Project 19.36 – Hayden Garage Roof Replacement was issued on February 27, 2023. The necessary legal notice was published in the <u>Plain Dealer</u> and <u>Call & Post</u> newspapers. The IFB was also published on the RTA web site.

The Invitation for Bid ("IFB") was accessed and/or downloaded from the web site by twenty-seven (27) interested parties. Four bids were received and opened on April 6, 2023. The bids received were as follows:

The Basis of Award is the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder for the Total Base Bid price. Terik Roofing, Inc. was determined to be a responsive bidder.

RECOMMENDATION:

The Office of Business Development has set a 20% DBE participation goal for this project. Terik Roofing, Inc. intends on using Contractor Connection, Inc., River City Building Solutions, LLC, and ROMA Designs, LLC to meet this goal.

Terik Roofing, Inc., has successfully completed projects for Cleveland State University, Cuyahoga County, the Lubrizol Corporation, and Progressive Insurance, among others.

A resolution will request authorization to issue a contract to Terik Roofing, Inc. for the Hayden Garage Roof Replacement in an amount not to exceed \$5,688,162.00. This bid is 20.9% below the Engineer's Estimate of \$7,191,778.88.

SUMMARY OF AWARD Catenary Rehabilitation Phase 2

PROJECT OVERVIEW:

The Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority (GCRTA) has the need to rehabilitate the catenary poles along the Red Line, Waterfront Line, and Main Rail Yard. This work includes, but is not limited to repairing poles, base plates, anchor bolts, structural arms, and down guys.

PROCUREMENT OVERVIEW:

The Invitation for Bid ("IFB") for Project 19.37 – Catenary Rehabilitation Phase 2 was issued on March 6, 2023. The necessary legal notice was published in the <u>Plain Dealer</u> and <u>Call & Post</u> newspapers. The Invitation for Bid was also published on the RTA web site.

The Invitation for Bid ("IFB") was accessed and/or downloaded from the web site by eleven (11) interested parties. Two (2) bids were received and opened on April 5, 2023. The responsive bids are as follows:

Suburban Maintenance & Construction, Inc.	\$3,863,000.00

The Basis of Award is the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder for the Total Base Bid price. Railworks Track Services, LLC was determined to be a responsive bidder.

RECOMMENDATION:

The Office of Business Development has set a 15% DBE participation goal for this project. Railworks Track Services, LLC intends on using Cook Paving and Construction Co., Inc. to meet this goal.

Railworks Track Services, LLC, has successfully completed projects for GCRTA, Norfolk Southern, Burlington Northern Santa Fe Railroad, and Canadian Pacific, among others.

A resolution will request authorization to issue a contract to Railworks Track Services, LLC for the Catenary Rehabilitation Phase 2 in an amount not to exceed \$3,799,835.00. This bid is approximately 8% above the Engineer's Estimate of \$3,517,142.00.

SUMMARY OF AWARD Rehabilitation of Track/Platform Bridges over W. 117th Street

PROJECT OVERVIEW:

The Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority (GCRTA) has the need to rehabilitate the track/platform bridges over W. 117th Street. The work to be performed under this contract entails replacement of the Eastbound and Westbound bridge decks, structural steel support brackets, pier bearing replacement, substructure retrofits/rehabilitation, removal of existing platform and construction of a new fiber reinforced platform deck, canopy roof repairs, micro pile installation, ballast removal and replacement, track and tie removal and reuse, headhouse work, ballast retainer installation, and bridge painting.

PROCUREMENT OVERVIEW:

The Invitation for Bid ("IFB") for Project 62A – Rehabilitation of Track/Platform Bridges over W. 117th Street was issued on February 27, 2023. The necessary legal notice was published in the <u>Plain Dealer</u> and <u>Call & Post</u> newspapers. The IFB was also published on the RTA web site.

The Invitation for Bid ("IFB") was accessed and/or downloaded from the web site by thirty-seven (37) interested parties. Two (2) bids were received and opened on April 13, 2023. One (1) bid was deemed to be unresponsive. The responsive bid was as follows:

Suburban Maintenance & Construction, Inc. intends on using Cuyahoga Fence, LLC, Tech Concrete, DGL Associates, AKA Waterproofing, Cook Construction Co., American Roadway Logistics, Baseline Supply, and Denise's Flagging, LLC to meet this goal.

Suburban Maintenance & Construction, Inc., has successfully completed projects for GCRTA, the Ohio Turnpike Commission, Ohio Department of Transportation, among others.

A resolution will request authorization to issue a contract to Suburban Maintenance & Construction, Inc. for the Rehabilitation of Track/Platform Bridges over W. 117th Street in an amount not to exceed \$7,563,549.00. This bid is 1.9% below the Engineer's Estimate of \$7,706,250.00.
