All Bus Operators

SUBJECT: Intersection: Euclid and Adelbert – Bike Lane ends and Bicycles Merge with Traffic.

At Euclid and Adelbert the bike lane ends and bicyclists must merge into regular traffic. Bus Operators must be aware of any bicyclists beside them or near them at this location so that six (6) feet of safe distance is provided to the bicyclists. The bus will need to vacate the curb lane to allow the designated distance of six (6) feet.

If you are behind the bicyclist at the far side of this intersection and want to pass, as an Operator you must do the following:

- Signal audibly to the bicycle being overtaken.
- Leave a safe distance, but not less than six (6) feet, and
- Vacate the lane in which the bicycle user is located when he/she passes, unless he/she can pass with a safe distance not less than six (6) feet.
- Maintain that distance until safely past the overtaken bicycle.



Bike lane ends at Adelbert on Euclid. Lane narrows and bike lane merges with normal traffic.
