

ADOPTING A FIVE-YEAR TRANSIT DEVELOPMENT PLAN

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority:


Section 1. That the Authority hereby adopts as a minimum a \$62,500,000 transit development program based upon the short-term program of the Five County Transit Study.

Section 2. That the development program will provide the following:

1. Buses	\$20,000,000	Approximately 300
2. Facility Upgrading	12,000,000	Central shops, garages
3. Maintenance Equipment and Routine Capital	2,000,000	Shop equipment, trucks, supervisory auto, office equip.
4. Shelters	1,000,000	Approximately 500
5. Rapid Transit Refurbishing, Stations and Right-of-Way	6,500,000	Station bldgs., parking lots, embankments, shops and track
6. Bus priority Systems	2,000,000	Roadways, ramps signals, park-and-ride lots
7. Rapid cars	<u>19,000,000</u>	<u>Approximately 60</u>
Total	62,500,000	
Local Share	12,500,000	
Average Per Year	2,500,000	

Section 3. That this resolution shall become effective immediately.
