

RESOLUTION NO. 1975-19

DIRECTING THE PLANNING COMMITTEE TO SEEK CONSULTING ASSISTANCE FOR THE PURPOSE OF UNDERTAKING MANAGEMENT AND ORGANIZATIONAL STUDIES, TO REVIEW START-UP PROCEDURES, AND TO DEVELOP COORDINATION OF THE NEW SYSTEM.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the Authority hereby directs the Planning Committee to interview management consulting firms with the intent of recommending a series of management and organizational studies on behalf of the Authority.

Section 2. That the studies, determined by the Authority, shall include but not be limited to the following:

- A. Developing the most comprehensive and efficient program for the use of human resources to give the Greater Cleveland area the best possible transit service.
- B. Expediting the coordination of RTA services with those systems where contracts have been agreed to; and
- C. Reviewing and establishing appropriate start-up procedures to facilitate the Authority's operation no later than October 5, 1975.

Section 3. That the fees paid for such consulting services shall not exceed the amount received for such purposes from state and federal authorities.

Section 4. That the Authority shall promptly deal with the recommendations of the Planning Committee under this resolution.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately.
