



# Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority Ridership Report: December 2019

## Summary

- Total ridership for December 2019 decreased 7% from December 2018
- The year to date goal for total ridership through December is 35 million. The actual year to date ridership through December is 32.7 million, or about 6% below goal
- December 2019 had one more weekday and one less weekend day than December 2018
  - Average weekday ridership decreased 12% from December 2018
  - Average weekend ridership decreased 9% from December 2018



**Bus** – Total bus ridership for December 2019 decreased 9% from December 2018

- Average weekday ridership decreased 13% from December 2018
- Average weekend ridership decreased 10% from December 2018



**Rail** – Total rail ridership for December 2019 decreased 6% from December 2018

- Average weekday ridership decreased 11% from December 2018
- Average weekend ridership decreased 6% from December 2018



**HealthLine** – Total HealthLine ridership for December 2019 decreased 2% from December 2018

- Average weekday ridership decreased 5% from December 2018
- Average weekend decreased 10% from December 2018



**Trolley** – Total Trolley ridership for December 2019 decreased 14% from December 2018

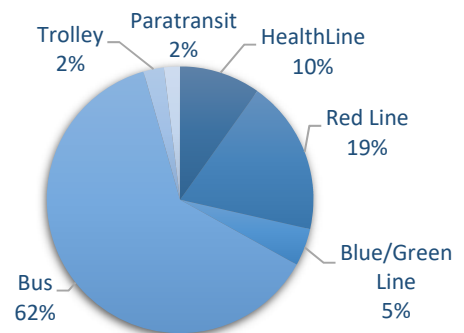
- Average weekday ridership decreased 18% from December 2018
- Average weekend ridership decreased 13% from December 2018



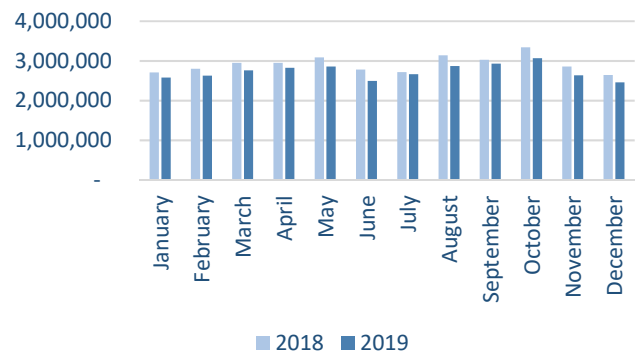
**Paratransit** – Total paratransit ridership for December 2019 increased .2% from December 2018

- Average daily ridership increased .2% from December 2018
