

Blue-Green Line Replacement Bus

- Replacement bus service will operate while train service is suspended: six weeks starting June 28
- Replacement bus service design recognizes that some downtown jobs will still be work-from-home
- Stations with high or medium ridership have priority
- Service plan was discussed with Shaker Hts. officials

Blue-Green Line Replacement Bus

- Using one alignment to serve both branches means customers of low-ridership stations (8 to 28 weekday inbound boardings, pre-COVID) will walk, bike, or drive farther to board the replacement bus service
- The added distance is 0.4 mile to 1.0 mile
- About 4% of all light rail customers are affected



Adjustments to Regular Bus Routes

Service frequency to be partly restored on some routes

- Route #1 St. Clair Avenue
- Route #3 Superior Avenue
- HealthLine Euclid Avenue
- MetroHealth Line West 25th Street

Staff is closely watching ridership and expenses
