

Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority Ridership Report – October 2020

Summary

- The COVID-19 pandemic continued to affect ridership
- System ridership in October was 1.3 million, representing 57% fewer riders than in October 2019
 - o Average fixed route weekday was 58% lower¹
 - o Average fixed route Saturday was 43% lower1
 - o Average fixed route Sunday was 47% lower¹
- Year-to-date ridership is 15.0 million, representing 45% fewer riders than through October 2019



Motorbus (MB)

Motorbus ridership in October 2020 was 57% lower than in October 2019

- Average weekday was 58% lower¹
- Average Saturday was 42% lower¹
- Average Sunday was 45% lower¹



Red Line (HR)

Red Line ridership in October 2020 was 56% lower than in October 2019

- Average weekday was 57% lower¹
- Average Saturday was 44% lower¹
- Average Sunday was 45% lower¹



Light Rail (LR)

Light Rail ridership in October 2020 was 67% lower than in October 2019

- Average weekday was 67% lower¹
- Average Saturday was 49% lower¹
- Average Sunday was 74% lower¹



HealthLine (RB)

HealthLine ridership in October 2020 was 53% lower than in October 2019


- Average weekday was 55% lower¹
- Average Saturday was 39% lower¹
- Average Sunday was 45% lower¹




Paratransit (DR)

Paratransit ridership in October 2020 was 40% lower than in October 2019


October 2020 System Ridership by Mode




System Ridership by Month
