Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority Ridership Report – November 2020

Summary

- The COVID-19 pandemic continued to affect ridership
- Both rail transit modes experienced a significant drop in Sunday ridership due to limited attendance at Browns' home games during November 2020
- System ridership in November was 1.2 million, representing 55% fewer riders than in November 2019
 - o Average fixed route weekday was 57% lower¹
 - o Average fixed route Saturday was 45% lower¹
 - o Average fixed route Sunday was 52% lower¹
- Year-to-date ridership is 16.1 million, representing 46% fewer riders than through November 2019

Motorbus (MB)

- Motorbus ridership in November 2020 was 54% lower than in November 2019
- Average weekday was 56% lower¹
- Average Saturday was 41% lower¹
- Average Sunday was 45% lower¹

Red Line (HR)

Red Line ridership in November 2020 was 58% lower than in November 2019

- Average weekday was 58% lower¹
- Average Saturday was 54% lower¹
- Average Sunday was 60% lower¹

Light Rail (LR)

Light Rail ridership in November 2020 was 68% lower than in November 2019

- Average weekday was 68% lower¹
- Average Saturday was 56% lower¹
- Average Sunday was 77% lower¹

HealthLine (RB)


HealthLine ridership in November 2020 was 51% lower than in November 2019

- Average Saturday was 41% lower¹
- Average Sunday was 45% lower¹




Paratransit (DR)


Paratransit ridership in November 2020 was 42% lower than in November 2019








Average Ridership (excluding Paratransit) by Day Type
