Public Hearing Notice

The Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority (GCRTA) is holding a Public Hearing to describe and receive public comments on proposed bus service additions, eliminations and modifications in our service area effective November 4. RTA is proposing the following service changes in the communities of North Olmsted, Olmsted Falls, Olmsted Twp. and Fairview Park:

Route #63F: Modify existing routes #63F Lorain Rd.-Great Northern Park-N-Ride (to be designated 263 North Olmsted Park-N-Ride) in the following manner: The A.M. eastbound route would operate current route to Lorain-Brookpark, then east on Lorain, south on Great Northern Blvd. to the Park-N-Ride, then via I-480/I-71 to downtown. The westbound P.M. route would be the reverse. Some trips will operate only between the Park-N-Ride facility and Downtown. In the off-peak periods (weekday midday and early evening), service to the Park-N-Ride will be available on route #75X North Olmsted.

Route #64F: Modify existing route #64F Olmsted Falls to serve the new Park-N-Ride/Transit Center in the following manner: The A.M. eastbound route would operate current route to Country Club Blvd.-Great Northern Blvd., then south on Great Northern Blvd. to the Park-N-Ride. The westbound P.M. route would be the reverse. The #64 will be operated as a local feeder route to the Park-N-Ride, where passengers can transfer to the new 263 route.

Route #96F: Modify existing route #96F Butternut/I-90 in the following manner: The A.M. eastbound route would operate current route to Columbia-Mastick, then north on Columbia, east on Brookpark, south on Clague to Mastick, then continue regular route. The westbound P.M. route would be the reverse.

Route #75F: Discontinue route #75F. Service along Lorain Rd. will still be provided by route 75X North Olmsted and along West 220th St. on route #96F Butternut/I-90. RTA is proposing the following service changes in the communities of North Olmsted, Olmsted Falls, Olmsted Twp., and Fairview Park.
