## Football Flyer buses offer service from six sites

RTA offers non-stop bus service from six sites to all Browns home games. Buses leave 1.5 hours before game time. Buses from Solon leave 1.75 hours before the game.

After the game, you can board the bus near the Stadium and return home. Adult one-way cash fare is \$2.50 – no tickets or passes will be accepted.

RTA will operate these routes to all pre-season and regular season home games.

- #920, Parmatown Transit Center, 8555 Day Dr., near the Parmatown Mall.
- #941, Solon Square, 33000 Aurora Rd. (Rt. 43) at Solon Blvd. Park in designated RTA area in the middle of the parking lot.
- #946, Westlake Park-N-Ride, 24800 Sperry Rd., near the Columbia Rd. exit of I-90.
- #951, Strongsville Park-N-Ride, 9355 Pearl Rd., at the entrance to the Ohio Turnpike.
- #975, North Olmsted Park-N-Ride, 5575 Great Northern Blvd. at I-480, southeast corner.
- #977, Brecksville Municipal Parking lot, 9021 Brecksville Rd. south of Royalton Rd.

## RTA service always scores with Browns

The Browns play 10 home games this year, and RTA is ready to take you to each of them.

RTA offers extra rail service before and after each home game, plus direct, non-stop flyer service to the Browns Stadium from six sites.

This month, pre-season home games are 7:30 p.m. Aug. 11 against the Kansas City Chiefs, and 7 p.m. Aug. 18 against the Detroit Lions.

Ride any RTA rail line to Tower City. Riders on the Blue and Green Lines can usually stay on the train to reach the Waterfront Line. Red Line riders can transfer to the Waterfront Line.

Waterfront Line trains drop off riders at the West Third Street Station, across the street from the Browns Stadium. Extra service begins two hours before each game.

Fans are urged to purchase a \$3.50 All-Day Pass, which includes unlimited ridership. All-Day Passes are available from every RTA farebox.

RTA offers more than 7,000 free parking spaces at rail stations and park-and-ride lots throughout Cuyahoga County.

## Some RTA timetables change on Sunday, Aug. 19

Service changes take effect Sunday, Aug. 19.

Two seasonal routes are affected. Saturday, Aug. 18, is the last day of service for the #20C bus, which runs from Public Square to the Metroparks Zoo. The #441 route to Geauga Lake operates daily through Aug. 26, and then returns for Labor Day weekend, Sept. 1-3.

### The #30 and parts of the #20A, #35 and #81 will operate 24 hours a day.

New timetables are being issued for the: #2, #6, #9X, #14, #15, #19, #20A, #22, #27F, #28, #30, #32X, #34, #35, #37, #38, #40, #41A/C, #47, #51X, #55X, #67X/#67AX, #70, #76X/F, #78, #79A/B, #81, #86, #86F, #801, #802, #804, #809, #820.

A number of supplemental service routes for the school year are also affected. They are discussed below.

Some timetable changes deserve special mention.

The #30 and parts of the #20A, #35 and #81 will operate 24 hours a day.

**#15 Union-Harvard:** The Country Lane branch will operate earlier and later on weekends and weekdays.

**#28 Euclid-East 276:** One morning round trip and one evening round trip will operate from Windermere to Lakeshore-East 222<sup>nd</sup>. Trips that currently start or end at Cliffview-North Green will be discontinued.

**#47 Mundy Lot-Public Square Loop:** Because of low mid-day ridership, service will be discontinued from 9:30 a.m. to 2:45 p.m.

**#86 Warren-Berea and #86F Berea-Olmsted Falls:** Buses will operate in both directions through the Berea Commons Municipal Parking Lot.

**#801 Lee-Harvard Community Circulator:** Route deviations to the Randall Park Mall and the East 131<sup>st</sup> – Caine Loop will be discontinued.

**#804 Lakewood Community Circulator:** From 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. each day, service will operate on West 117<sup>th</sup> Street and West 115<sup>th</sup> Street, between Lake Avenue and Clifton Boulevard.

#### Supplemental routes

These routes help handle the anticipated heavier passenger loads during the school year.

The following routes will resume operation, and new timetables will be available for each:

#702, #704, #722, #742, #743, #761, #762, #765, #781, #782, #783, #784, #785, #791 and #792.

Because of low ridership, all service has been discontinued on the #703, #723, #744 and #745.

Also discontinued are the #702 AM trip from the Brookpark Rapid Station and the #743 AM trip.

In addition, the #724 has been replaced with a new branch on the #28 Euclid-East 276<sup>th</sup> route.

Lastly, the PM routing of the #722 has been modified to mirror the AM routing.

## Bus service set for Burning River Fest

RTA will operate bus service to the Great Lakes Burning River Fest on Saturday, Aug. 11.

The service will operate frequently between the West Blvd./Cudell Red Line Station and Edgewater Park from 12:30-10 p.m. The station, on Detroit Avenue near West Boulevard, was formerly called West 98th/Detroit Station.

The one-way cash fare is \$1.50; valid RTA tickets and passes will also be accepted. Parking at the station is very limited. Those planning to drive should park at one of the these Red Line stations that have large park-n-ride lots:

- Triskett, 4200 W. 140th St., Cleveland
- Brookpark, 18010 Brookpark Rd., Cleveland
- Windermere, 14233 Euclid Ave., East Cleveland

- Green Road, 22900 Shaker Blvd., Shaker Heights
