SUPPLEMENTAL BUS SERVICE

Each year, when public and parochial schools are in session, RTA provides extra, or supplemental, bus service in various areas throughout the County. The purpose of this supplemental service is to prevent overcrowding on regular RTA bus routes when students are traveling to and from school.

In some instances the supplemental service trips are additional trips operating along all or part of a regular RTA bus route. These trips are identified on the public timetables. In other instances, however, the routing of the supplemental service is a combination of regular bus services in the same area. The routings and times for these supplemental trips have been grouped geographically and are provided on the following four (4) area public timetables:

- Supplemental Service for Eastern/Northeastern Cuyahoga County
- Supplemental Service for Southeastern Cuyahoga County

- Supplemental Service for Northwestern/Southwestern Cuyahoga County
- Supplemental Service for Western Cuyahoga County

Supplemental services are considered "regular" bus service. Supplemental fares are the same as fares for other RTA bus routes. If you are paying a cash fare, have the exact fare ready as drivers carry no change.

Please remember that the purpose of supplemental services is to prevent over-crowding on regular bus routes when schools are in session. **Therefore, supplemental services operate on weekdays only when school is in session and are not provided during the summer months and at other times when schools are not in session.**

All supplemental services stop at all RTA stops and are open to the public.

 **All trips are wheelchair accessible.**
