Engineering Services for the Rehab of Nine (9) Grade Crossings

- Construction budget \$7.5 million
- Engineering services required:
 - Investigation and Preliminary Engineering
 - Design and Engineering Development
 - Construction Documents
 - Bidding and Construction Assistance
- 3 projects – 3 grade crossings/year
