



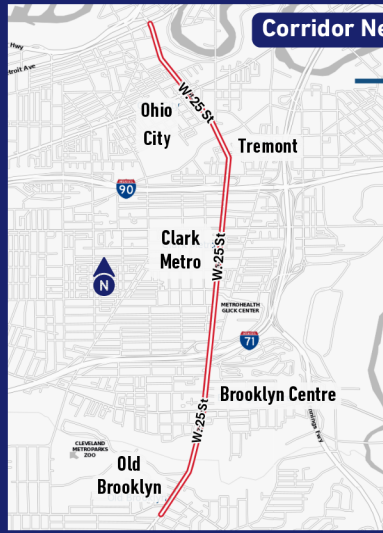
W. 25 MetroHealth Line BRT Project

The **MetroHealth Line Bus Rapid Transit (BRT)** project aims to utilize the 25Connects study to transform the West 25th Street (U.S. Route 42) corridor into a reliable transit route by improving transportation services, infrastructure, multi-modal access, and fostering equitable economic development. Key components of the BRT include bus lanes, enhanced bus waiting environments, and transit signal priority.

ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT IN PROJECT CORRIDOR

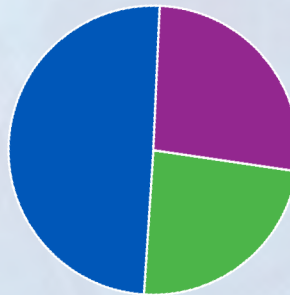


Corridor Neighborhoods

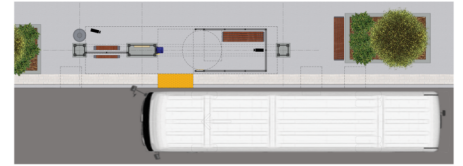

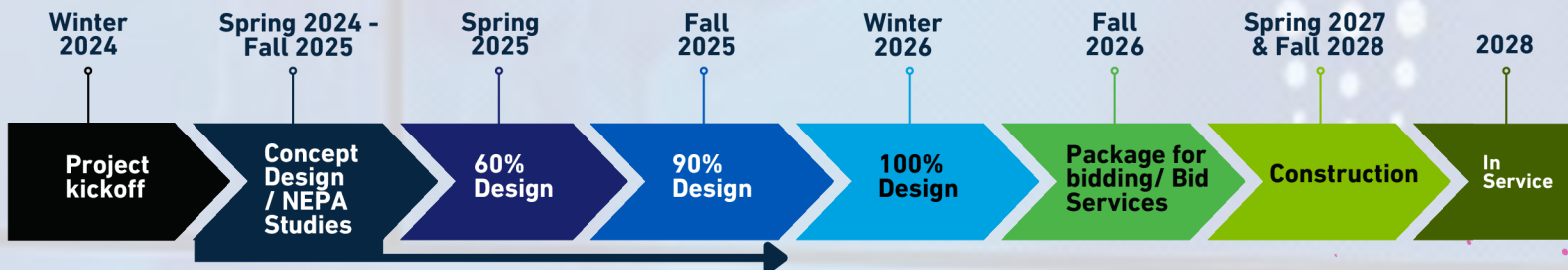
