

RESOLUTION NO. 1975-16

IN APPRECIATION OF JAY HANNA AND THE CITIZENS  
COMMITTEE FOR THEIR EFFORTS IN THE SUCCESSFUL  
CAMPAIGN TO PASS THE ONE PER CENT SALES TAX  
LEVY ON JULY 22, 1975

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater  
Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the Authority extend its unending appre-  
ciation to Jay Hanna, the Citizens Committee, and all those  
whose efforts resulted in the overwhelming vote of confidence  
in regional transit at the July 22, 1975, election.

Section 2. That the countless hours spent over the past  
two months by Jay Hanna and the Citizens Committee clearly  
resulted in the high level of public awareness and understanding  
of regional transit needs in Greater Cleveland and were instru-  
mental in the public's support at the polls.

Section 3. That since the 70.2% YES vote is the highest  
ever achieved by a transit-related issue in a major city in the  
United States, this in itself, is appropriate tribute to the  
special achievement of the Citizens Committee.

Section 4. That due to the public commitment to regional  
transit expressed by the electorate on July 22, the Authority  
hereby reaffirms its pledge to provide the citizens of Greater  
Cleveland the finest transit services possible.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective  
immediately.
