

RESOLUTION NO. 1977-268

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN EMERGENCY CONTRACT WITH TRANSPORT OF NEW JERSEY FOR THE PURCHASE OF TWO (2) PCC CARS.
(Est. \$100,000.00 - General Income Fund)

WHEREAS, light rail car numbers 59 and 65 are beyond economical repair; and

WHEREAS, replacement of these cars is necessary to maintain service levels; and

WHEREAS, compatability with present equipment is critical; and

WHEREAS, the present situation is an inconvenience to the riders of the Authority; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE GREATER CLEVELAND REGIONAL TRANSIT AUTHORITY, CUYAHOGA COUNTY, OHIO:


Section 1. That an emergency exists in the operation of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority.

Section 2. That an emergency contract be awarded the Transport of New Jersey for the purchase of two (2) PCC cars, involving an expenditure of not to exceed \$50,000.00 per car, and the President of the Board of Trustees is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with said company for the furnishing of said item.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the General Income Fund.

Section 4. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
