A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH THE SPOHN CORPORATION FOR REPLACEMENT HEATERS AT BROOKLYN GARAGE (\$26,000.00 - GENERAL FUND)

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1.
