RESOLUTION NO. 2008-153

AUTHORIZING THE GENERAL MANAGER/SECRETARY-TREASURER TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH MEDINA COUNTY FOR THE AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION SERVICES TO MEDINA COUNTY, OHIO

- WHEREAS, Medina County has requested that the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority (GCRTA) provide transportation services to Medina County; and
- WHEREAS, Governor Strickland has committed to provide funds to transit systems, including Medina County, to lessen the impact of increasing fuel costs and to support continuing public transportation service in the State of Ohio; and
- WHEREAS, Medina County will pass-through, to the Authority, a total of \$66,000 received from the State of Ohio so that the Authority can continue to provide public transportation services to Medina County; and
- WHEREAS, the pass-through of State of Ohio funds will impose certain obligations upon the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, including but not limited to Federal requirements.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority:
- Section 1. That the General Manager/Secretary-Treasurer is hereby authorized to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with Medina County, Ohio to provide transportation services to Medina County for a period of one (1) year.
- Section 2. That Medina County will pass-through to the Authority, funds received from the State of Ohio for payment of said services for a period of one year in the amount of \$66,000.
- Section 3. That the General Manager/Secretary-Treasurer of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority is authorized to accept the funds resulting from the State of Ohio financial assistance.
- Section 4. That the General Manager/Secretary-Treasurer is authorized to furnish such additional information as the State of Ohio may require in connection with the pass-through of said funds.
- Section 5. That, in the absence of the General Manager/Secretary-Treasurer, the Acting General Manager/Secretary-Treasurer of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority is hereby authorized to perform any and all of the above-described functions.



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

BETWEEN

THE GREATER CLEVELAND REGIONAL TRANSIT AUTHORITY

AND

MEDINA COUNTY, OHIO

This Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") is made on October ______, 2008 between the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority ("GCRTA"), a political subdivision of the State of Ohio, with a business address of 1240 W. 6th St., Cleveland, OH 44113, and Medina County, Ohio ("Medina County"), a county located in the State of Ohio, with a business address of 144 N. Broadway St., Medina, OH 44256.

WHEREAS, the purpose of this MOU is to formalize the transfer of funds from Medina

County to the GCRTA for the purpose of continued public transportation services in Medina

County for one (1) year: and

WHEREAS, Governor Strickland has committed to provide funds to transit systems, including Medina County, to lessen the impact of increasing fuel costs and to support continuing public transportation service in the State of Ohio; and

WHEREAS, Medina County wishes to have GCRTA provide transportation services to Medina County beginning November 9, 2008 and continuing for a one (1) year period ending November 8, 2009, and GCRTA is willing to provide said transportation services; and

WHEREAS, Medina County has agreed to pass-through to GCRTA funds received from the State of Ohio, in the amount of \$66,000.00 so that GCRTA can continue to provide public transportation service to Medina County residents for one (1) year, beginning November 9, 2008.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises, covenants and obligations contained herein, the GCRTA and Medina County agree as follows:



Section 1. That Medina County will pass-through \$66,000.00 to the GCRTA, and the GCRTA will, in turn, continue public transportation service to the residents of Medina County for one (1) year commencing November 9, 2008.

Section 2. Payment shall be made to the GCRTA in twelve (12) equal monthly payments, in advance of service, with first payment being due on or before November 9, 2008.

Section 3. Medina County acknowledges that it is a subrecipient of federal funds and, as such, it shall be subject to all federal laws, rules, regulations and executive orders governing federal grantees as they may be amended from time to time during the course of this contract. Medina County shall be responsible for local match requirements, if applicable. All terms mandated by the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) shall be deemed to control this agreement in the event of a conflict with other provisions contained herein. Medina County shall not perform any act, fail to perform any act, or refuse to comply with any GCRTA request related to the subject matter of this agreement that would cause GCRTA to be in violation of FTA terms and conditions, federal law and/or federal regulations. For purposes of this agreement, Medina County agrees to be bound by and in compliance with all mandatory federal requirements imposed upon recipients of federal funds as they may be amended including, but not limited to:

- (a) Prompt payment of subcontractors (49 CFR Part 26)
- (b) Restrictions on lobbying (49 CFR Part 20)
- (c) Civil Rights (49 USC 5332; 42 USC 2000d et seq.; 49 CFR Parts 21, 25, 26, 27, 37, 38, and 609; Title VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, as amended; 42 USC 2000e; 41 CFR Part 60 et seq; Executive Order 11246; 20 USC 1681 et seq.; 42 USC 6101 et seq.; 49 USC 5301(d); 29 USC 794; 42 USC 12101 et seq.; 42 USC 4151 et seq.; 36 CFR Part 1192; 28 CFR Parts 35 and 36; 41 CFR Subpart 101-19; 29 CFR Part 1630; 47 CFR Part 64, Subpart F; 36 CFR Part 1194; 21 USC 1174 et seq; 42 USC 4581 et seq., 42 USC 290dd-3 and 290ee-3)
- (d) Access to records (49 USC 5325(a))
- (e) Patent Rights (35 USC 200 et seq.; and 37 CFR Part 401)
- (f) Employee Protections (40 USC 3141 et seq.; 49 USC 5333(a); 40 USC 3701 et seq.; 29 CFR Part 5; 40 USC 3704; 29 CFR Part 1926; 18 USC 874; 29 CFR Part 3; and 29 USC 201)



- (g) Environmental requirements (42 USC 4321-4335; Executive Order 11514; 49 USC 5324; 40 CFR Part 1500-1508; 23 CFR Part 771; and 49 CFR Part 662; 16 USC 470f; Executive Order 11593; 16 USC 470; and 16 USC 469a-469c)
- (h) Buy America (49 USC 5323 and 49 CFR Part 661).

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the GCRTA and Medina County have caused this MOU to be executed effective on the date written above.
