



Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority Ridership Report: January 2020

Summary

- Total ridership for January 2020 decreased 1% from January 2019
- The year to date goal for total ridership through January is 2.8 million. The actual year to date ridership through January is 2.5 million, or about 10% below goal
- January 2020 had the same number of weekdays and weekend days as January 2019
 - Average weekday ridership increased 4% from January 2019
 - Average weekend ridership decreased 11% from January 2019



Bus – Total bus ridership for January 2020 decreased .1% from January 2019

- Average weekday ridership increased 4% from January 2019
- Average weekend ridership decreased 12% from January 2019



Rail – Total rail ridership for January 2020 decreased 4% from January 2019

- Average weekday ridership decreased 2% from January 2019
- Average weekend ridership decreased 11% from January 2019



HealthLine – Total HealthLine ridership for January 2020 increased 8% from January 2019

- Average weekday ridership increased 13% from January 2019
- Average weekend ridership decreased 12% from January 2019




Trolley – Total Trolley ridership for January 2020 increased 19% from January 2019

- Average weekday ridership increased 20% from January 2019
- Average weekend ridership increased 4% from January 2019




Paratransit – Paratransit ridership will be added when available.
