Information on IFB Procurement

At the July 14, 2020 Operational Planning & Infrastructure Committee meeting, we will make a presentation on the IFB procurement for the rehabilitation of the Light Rail Trunk Line Guard Walls and Retaining Walls from East 103rd to Shaker Square.

This is the second of two rehabilitation projects along the Light Rail Trunk Line. The first was completed in 2017. This project will include the rehabilitation and replacement of the inlayed brick in the guard walls parallel to Shaker Boulevard, rehabilitation of retaining wall concrete adjacent to the tracks, and selective cutting of trees and undergrowth between the guard and retaining walls.

We will be requesting that the Operational Planning & Infrastructure Committee approve the recommendation that the contract be placed on the July 28, 2020 Board meeting agenda for action. We are providing the Board members with the attached Summary of Award for the Board's information.

Update on August Service Changes

At the July 14, 2020 meeting of the Operational Planning & Infrastructure Committee, staff will present the schedule adjustments that will take effect August 9, 2020. Service frequency will be increased on selected bus routes to ensure that enough capacity is available for fall 2020 ridership.

Also, the B-Line trolley route will operate every 15 minutes on a modified alignment that serves Public Square in both directions. All three Park-N-Ride routes will be restored at a 30-minute frequency that is sufficient to accommodate customers who will not be working from home this fall. The Blue Line and Green Line rail service will be restored to the pre-shutdown schedule.

System-wide (bus and rail combined) weekly vehicle-hours of service will grow to 93 percent of pre-COVID levels.

Proposed FY 2021 TAX BUDGET

On Tuesday, July 14, 2020, staff will present the Proposed 2021 Tax Budget with the explanations and financial assumptions. This is the first of two legislative steps to establish the financial plan for the upcoming Fiscal Year (FY). The Operational Planning and Infrastructure Committee will be asked to recommend the Proposed 2021 Tax Budget to the full Board for discussion and action at the July 28, 2020 RTA Board Meeting. Once the Tax Budget is adopted, it will be filed with the County Budget Commission.

The development of a Tax Budget requires an early review and analysis of the Authority's projected revenues and expenditures. It provides the initial framework for the next budget cycle and begins the process for formally adopting the FY 2021 budget appropriations. The Tax Budget defines anticipated expenses in very broad terms, but its primary emphasis is on expected revenues. Of significant concern for the upcoming budget years is the COVID-19 pandemic's impact to the Authority's two largest sources of revenue, the Sales & Use Tax and Passenger Fares and our ability to offset those losses with the remaining CARES Act funds that we have received from FTA.

To provide an opportunity for the public to comment, a formal public hearing will be held in the Board Room of the Authority on July 14, 2020.
