





- Implementation of Service Infractions software
 - Tracks no-shows, late cancels, and cancels-at-the-door
- Reduce cancellation rate (Currently 28%)
 - Down from 35% 40%




- ODJFS: \$11.8 billion unemployment payments paid over last 6 months










