#### **MEETING NOTICE**

Notice is hereby given that the following meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority will take place on <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>November 9</u>, <u>2021</u> in the Board Room of the Authority, 1240 West Sixth Street, Cleveland, OH 44113 for consideration of the listed items and such other items that may properly come before the Board and be acted upon.

This meeting will be live-streamed on RTA's Facebook page (<a href="www.facebook.com/rideRTA">www.facebook.com/rideRTA</a>) for staff and members of the public. Members of the public may also attend in-person. Based on Centers for Disease Control (CDC) guidance to continue to avoid large events and gatherings and Ohio Department of Public Health advice that businesses and other entities may continue to require mitigation measures, as well as RTA's interest in protecting community and employee health and safety, the following measures will be in place for in-person attendance:

- To allow for social distancing, RTA Board Room capacity is limited to forty-four (44) people. To accommodate members of the public, RTA will limit the number of staff permitted in the Board Room.
- 2. 

Information on Sole Source Procurement

This is a sole source procurement to provide the Occupied Zone Warning System to show train movements through the Shaker Junction on a screen at the ICC and notify train operators when a train is in the Shaker Junction with wayside flashing lights and in train notifications.

At the November 9, 2021 meeting of the Operational Planning & Infrastructure Committee, RTA staff will present the recommendation for award of Occupied Zone Warning System Contract.

This project will utilize the existing ProTracker System on the trains in combination with new wayside units to alert train operators when a train is stopped at, or approaching, the occupied zone.

This project will also provide and install mimic table software with associated communications to provide information on train location to the Control Center Supervisors located in the ICC, and emergency locations at Central Rail, Tower City, and Woodhill.

Staff request that the Operational Planning & Infrastructure Committee recommend award of this contract to the full Board for approval at the November 16, 2021 meeting. # SUMMARY OF PROPOSED AWARD Occupied Zone Warning System

#### PROJECT OVERVIEW:

The Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority is seeking a qualified firm to provide a train detection system to alert the Integrated Control Center (ICC) and operators approaching Shaker Junction when another train is entering and/or in the junction area

Shaker Junction has wayside signals that do not communicate with the ICC. Additionally, there is no interlocking to prevent conflicting movements through the junction. The Authority currently utilizes an on-board ProTracker system to alert operators of the presence of wayside workers. The occupied zone system solution will work with the existing on-board system to notify ICC and train operators of train movements through the junction. Implementing the occupied zone system will help prevent accidents at Shaker Junction.

### PROCUREMENT OVERVIEW:

The Authority currently utilizes Protran Protracker detection devices on all trains to alert operators and wayside workers of each other's presence. Harsco Rail, LLC is the sole provider of Protran Technology. They were the original provider of our on-board equipment and software, and the only firm who can provide equipment and software that integrates with its proprietary technology. Due to these reasons, this project is deemed a sole source procurement and is exempt from competitive bidding as authorized under both Section 306.43(H)(3) and 306.43(H)(6) of the Ohio Revised Code.

The Procurement Department requested a proposal from Harsco Rail, LLC on August 20, 2021. A proposal was received on September 8, 2021. The proposal was reviewed by representatives from Engineering, Safety, Power & Way and Procurement, and after negotiations, deemed to be advantageous, fair and reasonable to the Authority.

#### RECOMMENDATION

The committee recommends Harsco Rail, LLC, with an office at 350 Poplar Church Road, Camp Hill, Pennsylvania 17011 to provide an occupied zone warning system.

The strengths of Harsco Rail, LLC include:

- Established in 1909 with extensive experience maintaining track structures
- Global leader in track maintenance and structures
- Maintain a customer base of more than 125 railways throughout the world
- Protran Technology division is a leader in Secondary Advanced Warning Technology
- Protran Protracker equipment is currently installed on all GCRTA trains

A 0% DBE participation goal was assigned to this project by the Office of Business Development.

A resolution will request authorization to issue a contract to Harsco Rail, LLC to provide a Occupied Zone Warning System in a total negotiated contract amount not to exceed \$335,000.00. This amount is 4.7% above the Engineer's Estimate of \$320,000.00.
