- Total Task Orders not to exceed \$450,000 over a 24 month term.



- Work may include:
 - Highway-Rail grade crossing warning systems.
 - Wayside and Computer Assisted Braking systems.
 - Roadway Traffic Control Systems.
 - Vital Processer and CTDS interaction.
 - Regulatory compliance.
 - Training and specification development.



- Potential tasks include:
 - Replacement of Central Rail Yard track circuits.
 - Replacement of Tower City track circuits.
 - Signal and communication issues as they arise.

- Three (3) firms submitted proposals
- Three (3) firms were interviewed
