Ridership Report, January 2024



Summary

- Total ridership in January 2024 was 1.83M, which is a 5% increase from January 2023
 - Avg. fixed-route weekday increased 1%
 - Avg. fixed-route Saturday increased 31%
 - Avg. fixed-route Sunday decreased 4%

Bus (MB)

- Bus ridership in January 2024 was 1.25M, which is a 3% increase from January 2023
 - Average weekday decreased 1%
 - Average Saturday¹ increased 38%
 - Average Sunday¹ decreased 10%

Red Line/Heavy Rail (HR)

- Red Line ridership in January 2024 was 300K, which is a 4% increase from January 2023
 - Average weekday increased 2%
 - Average Saturday increased 2%
 - Average Sunday increased 7%

HealthLine (RB)

- HealthLine ridership in January 2024 was 149K, which is a 14% increase from January 2023
 - Average weekday increased 4%
 - Average Saturday¹ increased 167%
 - Average Sunday¹ decreased 22%

Light Rail (LR)

- Light Rail ridership in January 2024 was 65K, which is a 24% increase from January 2023
 - Average weekday increased 23%
 - Average Saturday increased 34%
 - Average Sunday decreased 5%

Paratransit (DR)

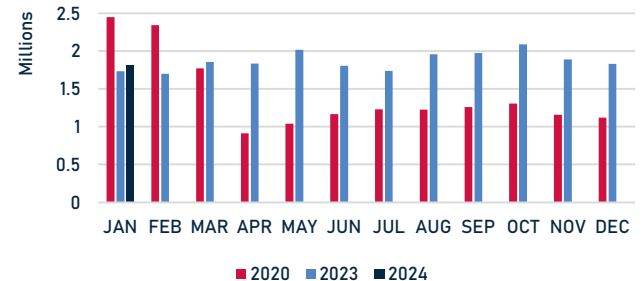
- Paratransit ridership in January 2024 was 50K, which is a 9% increase from January 2023

Note: Average ridership by day type does not include atypical days as defined by the Federal Transit Administration for National Transit Database reporting.

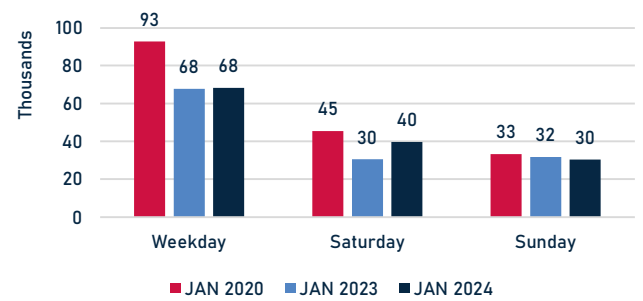
¹Due to new bus ridership sourcing methods, average weekend day comparisons in 2024 may vary when compared to previous years.

²Fixed-Route "typical" Sundays in December 2023 only included Christmas Eve, Christmas, and New Year's Eve.

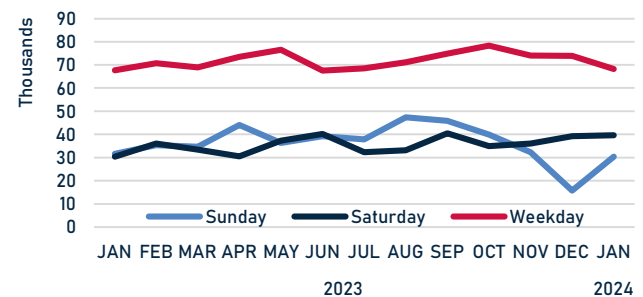
Total Ridership by Month
