





YTD Ridership (in millions)



YTD Passenger Fares (in millions)





Ohio Senate Finance Committee Testimony



India Birdsong Terry, General Manager & CEO Michael Gettings, Deputy Chief of Transit Police

May 28, 2025 | Columbus, Ohio

- We joined SARTA, SORTA, and COTA in testifying against House Omnibus Amendment H.C. 2285-1, following up on testimony earlier this month before the Ohio Senate Finance Committee
- Advised the amendment would jeopardize 1.5M annual student trips, undermine
 a cost-effective CMSD partnership, and raise concerns about the potential to
 undermine federal funding
- Emphasized the proposal would disproportionately impact urban school districts, limiting access for thousands of students traveling to charter, parochial, and suburban schools
