

SUMMARY



- The work proposed to be performed under this contract consists of repairs to abutments, wing walls, bridge bearing seats, pavement, and guardrail of the GCRTA CRMF access road bridges over Norfolk Southern. Also included is the restoration of the fascia beams of the CRMF access road bridge over East 37th Street.
- Staff recommends that the Board of Trustees authorize a contract to Suburban Maintenance & Construction for \$383,649.00.
- An Entry Agreement with Norfolk Southern is also necessary in the amount of \$172,431.00, which will reimburse NS Flagging and Engineering costs.
