CIP ISSUES & CHALLENGES

- Secure Bus Replacements Funding
- Declining Debt Service Ratio
 - Decreasing General Fund (GF) Balances
 - Reduces ability to support additional debt
- Identify Alternative Funding Sources and Compete for Non-Formula Awards
- Identify \$240 M for Replacement Rail Cars (2025)


