### Part I

 Community Resource Officers are permanently assigned to Triskett and Hayden Bus Districts

 Community Resource Officers to have daily communication with District Management, Dispatchers, Starters and Operators



# Part I (cont.)

Will coordinate the response to the identified problems

- $_{\odot}$  Uniformed presence on the bus
- $_{\odot}$  Plain clothes presence on the bus
- Detectives follow up with parents, school administrators, address school assembly

 $_{\odot}$  Coordination with the Prosecutor's office

Will provide feedback to the Operators / Problem resolution



## Part II

- Transit Police Officers to report to Bus Districts, at the beginning and ending of shifts
- TP footprint at Bus Districts
- Parking spaces for police vehicles, lockers, work station



# Part II (cont.)

Provides visibility and interaction with Operators

 Officers to address issues on bus routes identified by operators as problematic

Community Policing means collaboration with our security partners
