Intergovernmental Student Transportation Agreement – Cleveland Municipal School District (CMSD)

Overview

- CMSD wishes to make public transportation available to its enrolled students Grades 6 - 12
- One year agreement from July 18, 2016 - July 31, 2017
- To improve controls, GCRTA to provide magnetic stripe farebox compatible picture card ID passes with certain blackout dates around school holidays.

Highlights of Terms

- 18,000 farecards
- Free ride on first day of school for students to obtain picture IDs
- Total value of agreement of \$4,400,000 represents a 4.7% increase over last year
- Overall agreement is largely similar to prior year and will require a lump sum payment by August 31, 2016
- Any tickets provided for services over and above will be at \$1.65/ride which represents a 10% increase over last year

Recommendation

- Staff requests that the Finance Committee recommend to the Board of Trustees the approval of the Intergovernmental Student Transportation Agreement with CMSD for the 2016-17 school year
