Project Background

- The station expansion will be constructed as part of the Opportunity Corridor Phase 2 design-build project being administered by ODOT.
- The limits of the Opportunity Corridor Phase 2 project extend from E. 93rd street to just north of Quebec Ave.
- Construction budget for station expansion, \$4 million.

- Existing Station
 - Open air, constructed in 2004.
 - Single ADA access point from Quincy Ave.
 - One car concrete platform.
- Station Expansion
 - Provide second ADA access point from new E. 105th bridge.
 - Extend platform to three car length.
 - Match aesthetic characteristics of existing station.
















Existing Station – Platform Level












Site Plan











East Elevation












































Anticipated Project Schedule
