# Chapter 410 Procurement

- Procurement Policies are not currently included in the code book.
- Rename chapter from “Contracts & Procurement” to “Procurement.”

# Ethics – Participation in Procurement

- FTA’s procurement-specific ethics statement
- “employee or member of immediate family”
- “agent, board member, or his or her immediate family member, partner, or organization that employs or is about to employ any of the foregoing”

# Ethics - Gifts

- Revised to mirror language of the Ohio Revised Code.

# Delegations of Authority

- Consolidates authority shared by the CEO and the Director of Procurement.
- All substantive delegations to the CEO and the Director of Procurement remain the same.
- CEO's change order authority is unchanged.

# Procurement Planning

- Revised to reflect current practices
- User Department is responsible for preparing:
  - Specifications
  - Scope of services
  - Cost estimate



# Debarment

- State or Federal Debarment list



# Protests, Claims & Disputes

- Combined two policies into one
- Handled according to applicable federal and/or state regulations
- Procedure is in the Procurement Manual



# Procurement Types – Formal Contracts

- Procurement Department has discretion to determine type of procurement within parameters of applicable state and federal laws and regulations.

# Procurement Types - Small Purchases

- The small purchase limit remains \$100,000.00, as prescribed by Ohio R.C. 306.43.

# Procurement Types - Sealed Bid Procurements

- Director of Procurement shall determine when a sealed bid method of procurement is appropriate.

# Procurement Types - Non-Competitive Procurements

- Must be justified under state and federal law
- Examples: sole source, emergency
- Board approval above small purchase threshold
- Best interest of the Authority
- Price must be fair and reasonable

# Construction Services

- Removed requirement for individual trades
- Brings into compliance with current law
- Retained two requirements:
  - Conducted as sealed bid procurements
  - Lowest responsive and responsible bidder

# Bid Guaranty

- Bid guaranty prescribed in the Ohio Revised Code
- Replaces the “Bonds” policy



# Other Changes

- Pilot program policy moved to Chapter 242
- Arts in Transit policy in Chapter 1088
