Background

- Codified in 1989 (Resolution 1989-176)
- Review and update to bring policies in line with current operations
- Subject to review and revision every 3 years

Community Advisory Committee

- Recommend amending Section 222.04 Community Advisory Committee
 - Streamline subcommittee structure
 - Create Rules Subcommittee for review of Operating Guidelines

Community Advisory Committee

- Reduce number of members from 20 to 11-15
- Reduce terms from 3 to 2 years with a maximum of 2 terms
- Clarify provision regarding emeritus status
- Add requirement of Cuyahoga County residence

Background

- The Code Book was codified in 1989
- The Code Book is subject to review and revision every 3 years
- The Legal Department is currently updating the Code Book to bring it in line with current operations

Chapter 465 – Financial Assistance

- Chapter 465 gives the General Manager the authority to apply for and accept federal, state, and private grants
- This Chapter was last updated in 2016
- These requested changes will simply update the General Manager's title and update a few citations to the Code Book and United States Code
