- 2. Maximize the return on capital investments



Securing Additional Funding

- IIJA FTA formula grants provide approximately \$56M+ GCRTA Local Match of \$14M for base funding level of \$70M per year.
- SFY2024-2025 ODOT Office of Transit administers
 \$70M of Ohio General Revenue and Flex Funding and
 \$15M of new Workforce Mobility funding.
- Competitive grants at federal, state, and local level provide majority of funding beyond the base level.
