Existing roof conditions:


 Roof is over 25 years old and is showing obvious signs of aging.





Existing roof conditions cont'd.:


 Roof membrane has separated from the underlying wet insulation, resulting in bulging as shown here. This is typical throughout the entire roof.





Existing roof conditions cont'd.:

 Water leaks on A/C ducts and electrical conduits in workshop. This condition is common throughout.





Existing roof conditions cont'd.:

 Transition parapet wall had to be patched to reduce leaks into building.





Existing roof conditions cont'd.:

• Leak in Operator's recreation room.





Existing roof conditions cont'd.:


• Field repair similar to this is a common occurrence throughout.





Existing roof conditions cont'd.:

 Roof Mapping - Dark areas indicate moist insulation. This condition exists over approximately 10% of total roof area.

• Visual images of scanned area vs infrared view of area



Four (4) firms submitted a bid.

A 20% DBE participation goal was assigned to this project and will be achieved through the use of Contractor Connection, Inc., River City Solutions, LLC, and ROMA Designs, LLC.



Firm Experience:

• Terik Roofing, Inc. has successfully completed projects for Cleveland State University, Cuyahoga County, Lubrizol Corporation, and Progressive Insurance, among others.



Recommendation:

Staff requests that the Operational Planning and Infrastructure Committee recommend award to Terik Roofing, Inc. for the Hayden Garage Roof Replacement. The contract is in an amount not to exceed \$5,688,162.00. The Authority will use a 2022 competitive bus grant award to help fund this project.
