







History of Work

- Station, platform and Track Bridges constructed circa 1953
- Track Bridge Rehabilitation 1989
- Station and Headhouse Rehabilitation with new canopy rooftop 2008
- No significant platform deck work to date



Project Objectives

- Extend the three bridges and adjoining platform service life utilizing innovative design/construction methods & materials to:
 - Improve the collection & distribution of surface drainage
 - Provide proper expansion/contraction of platform & bridge
 - Rehabilitate head house entrance
 - Deliver solutions with least impact to revenue service

Ends

- Project rehabilitation elements:
 - Replace concrete track bridge decks, retrofit/paint existing structural steel, patch concrete foundations, and improve site drainage.
 - Replace concrete platform deck with Fiber Reinforced Polymer (FRP) deck while preserving existing canopy.
 - Patch city concrete curb walls and replace city sidewalk handrails.



Procurement Overview

Invitation For Bid (IFB) issued February 27, 2023.

Accessed on the GCRTA website by 37 interested parties.

Two (2) firms submitted a bid.

Suburban Maintenance & Construction, Inc.
