

RESOLUTION NO. 1989-45

AUTHORIZING CONTRACTS WITH INTERSTATE DIESEL SERVICES AND MUNCIE RECLAMATION AND SUPPLY FOR THE FURNISHING OF REBUILT FUEL INJECTORS IN THE AMOUNTS OF \$37,678.00 (INTERSTATE DIESEL SERVICES) AND \$23,725.50 (MUNCIE RECLAMATION AND SUPPLY) FOR A PERIOD OF ONE (1) YEAR (EST. \$61,403.50 - GENERAL FUND) - INVENTORY DEPARTMENT BUDGET

WHEREAS, the bids of Interstate Diesel Services and Muncie Reclamation and Supply for the furnishing of Rebuilt Fuel Injectors were received on the 23rd of March for the prices set forth in said bids involving estimated expenditures of Thirty-seven Thousand Six Hundred Seventy-Eight & 00/100 (\$37,678.00) for Interstate Diesel Services and Twenty Three Thousand Seven Hundred Twenty-Five and 50/100 (\$23,725.50) Dollars for Muncie Reclamation and Supply; and

WHEREAS, this procurement is divisible; and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of Interstate Diesel Services for Items #1, 2, 3, 5, 6, 8 & 9 of this IFB to be the lowest and best responsive bid from a responsible bidder with regard to said items of the IFB and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees; and

WHEREAS, the General manager deems the bid of Muncie Reclamation and Supply for Items #4 & 7 of the IFB to be the lowest and best responsive bid from a responsible bidder with regard to said items of the IFB and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Interstate Diesel Services for Items #1, 2, 3, 5, 6, 8 & 9 of the IFB be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest and best responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

Section 2. That the bid of Muncie Reclamation and Supply for Items #4 & 7 be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest and best responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

Section 3. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into contracts with Interstate Diesel Services and Muncie Reclamation and Supply for the furnishing of said items as required for a period of one (1) year.

Section 4. That said contract shall be payable out of the General Fund in an estimated amount not to exceed Thirty Seven Thousand Six Hundred Seventy-Eight and 00/100 (\$37,678.00) for Interstate Diesel Services and Twenty Three Thousand Seven Hundred Twenty-Five and 50/100 (\$23,725.50) Dollars for Muncie Reclamation and Supply.


Section 5. That said contracts shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractors to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 6. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
