

RESOLUTION NO. 1989-65

DECLARING WEDNESDAY, MAY 17, 1989, AS
GREATER CLEVELAND REGIONAL TRANSIT AUTHORITY
EMPLOYEE APPRECIATION DAY

WHEREAS, the week of May 14 through May 20, 1989, has been declared National Transportation Week; and

WHEREAS, May 17th has been declared National Transit Employee Appreciation Day; and

WHEREAS, the employees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority provide more than 28,000,000 miles of transit service annually; and

WHEREAS, the employees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority provide such service with dedication and high regard for the safety and well-being of the thousands of Greater Clevelanders who depend on them for daily transportation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority:

Section 2. That the employees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority are hereby commended for their dedicated service.
