

AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH WOOSTER IRON AND METAL, NIMCO SHREDDING, AND NORTHSIDE MOTORS FOR THE SALE OF TWENTY (20) NON-OPERABLE COACHES

WHEREAS, coach No. 2500, 2507, 2511, 2518, 2528, 2549, 2557, 2563, 2579, 2583, 2585, 2595, 2598, 8002, 8020, 8073, 8079, 8087, 8125, and 8130 have been determined to be obsolete in accordance with the Authority's bus replacement policy or in accordance with the Board of Trustee's previous Resolution 1986-141 authorizing the sale of American Motors General coaches; and

WHEREAS, The bids of Wooster Iron & Metal located at P.O. Box 173, Wooster, Ohio; Nimco Shredding located at P.O. Box 5158, Newark, New Jersey; and Northside Motors located at 3617 Lorain Ave., Cleveland, Ohio were received on the 9th day of February, 1990, for the total sale price of Eleven Thousand Eight Hundred Seventy-Three & 64/100 (\$11,873.64) Dollars;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bids of Wooster Iron & Metal, Nimco Shredding, and Northside Motors as listed below be and the same are hereby accepted as the highest responsive bids from responsible bidders:

Wooster Iron & Metal for the sale of coaches Nos. 2500, 2507, 2511, 2518, 2528, 2557, 2563, 2579, 2583, 2595, 2598, 8020, 8073, 8079, 8125, and 8130; for total purchase price of \$9,218.64.

Nimco Shredding for coach No. 2549; for total purchase price of \$385.00.

Northside Motors for the sale of coaches Nos. 2585, 8002, and 8087; for total purchase price of \$2,270.00.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into contracts with said companies for the sale of said property as described on such terms as are appropriate for the protection of the interests of the Authority.

Section 3. That the proceeds of said sales, Eleven Thousand Eight Hundred Seventy-Three & 64/100 (\$11,873.64) Dollars be deposited into the General Fund.

Section 4. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
