

**AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH SPECIAL BUSING, INC. FOR
THE FURNISHING OF THE UNIVERSITY CIRCLE CIRCULATOR
SERVICE FOR A PERIOD OF TWO (2) YEARS WITH AN OPTION
FOR A THIRD YEAR (\$1,088,136.00 - GENERAL FUND)
PARATRANSIT DEPARTMENT BUDGET**

WHEREAS, the bid of Special Busing, Inc. located at 1022 Mahoning Avenue, Youngstown, OH for the furnishing of the University Circle Circulator Service was received on the 14th day of May, 1990 for the price set forth in said bid, involving an estimated expenditure of one million eighty-eight thousand one hundred thirty-six & 00/100 dollars (\$1,088,136.00); and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid Special Busing, Inc. of to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Special Busing, Inc. for the furnishing of University Circle Circulator Service for a period of two (2) years with an option for a third year be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.


Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Special Busing, Inc. for the furnishing of the University Circle Circulator Service for a period of two (2) years with an option for a third year.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the General Fund in an estimated amount not to exceed one million eighty-eight thousand one hundred thirty-six 00/100 dollars (\$1,088,136.00).

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon appropriations for future contract years and upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1985-87; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
