

RESOLUTION NO. 1990-102

AUTHORIZING AN EXTENSION TO THE CONTRACT WITH  
WELLS FARGO GUARD SERVICE TO PROVIDE PROFESSIONAL  
SECURITY SERVICES AT VARIOUS GCRTA LOCATIONS FOR A  
PERIOD OF ONE MONTH (EST \$21,000.00 - GENERAL FUND) -  
TRANSIT POLICE DEPARTMENT BUDGET.

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 1988-68, adopted March 22, 1988  
authorized a contract with Wells Fargo Guard Service to provide  
Professional Security Services to the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit  
Authority for a period of two (2) years; and

WHEREAS, the continuation of present security services is  
essential to assure the safety of GCRTA customers and employees and is in  
the best interest of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority;  
and

WHEREAS, it is mutually agreeable to the Greater Cleveland  
Regional Transit Authority and to Wells Fargo Guard Services to extend  
the contract for a period of one (1) month in order to continue this  
vital service and allow the Authority to complete negotiations on a new  
contract; and

WHEREAS, the estimated cost of twenty-one thousand & 00/100  
dollars (\$21,000.00) to continue services for a period of one (1) month  
is based on current monthly billings;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the  
Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the General Manager be and his is hereby  
authorized to extend the contract with Wells Fargo Guard Service for a  
period of one (1) month at an estimated cost of twenty-one thousand &  
00/100 dollars (\$21,000.00) for a revised total estimated contract amount  
of four hundred twenty four-thousand nine hundred eighty nine & 00/100  
dollars (\$424,989.00).


Section 2. That said contract extension shall be payable from  
the General Fund.

Section 3. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1985-87; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.
