

**AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH WABCO PASSENGER TRANSIT DIVISION OF WESTINGHOUSE AIR BRAKE COMPANY FOR THE FURNISHING OF 12 EVAPORATOR BLOWER MOTORS FOR THE TOKYU HEAVY RAIL VEHICLES (\$47,340.00) TOTAL - OF WHICH 80% (\$37,872.00) IS FEDERALLY FUNDED THROUGH CAPITAL GRANT OH-90-0134.**

WHEREAS, the bid of WABCO Passenger Transit Division of Westinghouse Air Brake Company, located at P.O. Box 11, Spartanburg, SC 29304-0011, for the furnishing of twelve (12) evaporator blower motors was received on the 6th of November 1992, for the price set forth in said bid, involving an expenditure of forty-seven thousand three hundred forty & 00/100 dollars (\$47,340.00); and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of WABCO Passenger Transit Division of Westinghouse Air Brake Company, to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of WABCO Passenger Transit Division of Westinghouse Air Brake Company, be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with WABCO Passenger Transit Division of Westinghouse Air Brake Company, for the furnishing of twelve (12) evaporator blower motors for the Tokyu heavy rail vehicles.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of Capital Grant OH-90-0134 in an amount not to exceed forty-seven thousand three hundred forty & 00/100 dollars (\$47,340.00).

Section 4. That said contract is subject to Federal Transit Administration waiver of Buy America requirements.

Section 5. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1985-87; bonding and insurance requirements; and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 6. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
