

RESOLUTION NO. 1993-164

AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH MULTISYSTEMS, INCORPORATED FOR THE FURNISHING OF AN AUTOMATED DISPATCH AND PAYROLL INTERFACE SOFTWARE SYSTEM AT A TOTAL PRICE OF TWO HUNDRED FORTY-THREE THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE & 00/100 DOLLARS (\$243,761.00), RTA CAPITAL FUND - DATA SYSTEMS DEPARTMENT BUDGET.

WHEREAS, the bid of Multisystems, Incorporated located at 1050 Massachusetts Avenue, Cambridge, MA 02138-5381 for the furnishing of an Automated Dispatch and Payroll Interface Software System was received on the 30th of September, 1993, for a price set forth in said bid of two hundred forty-three thousand seven hundred sixty-one & 00/100 dollars (\$243,761.00); and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of Multisystems, Incorporated to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Multisystems, Incorporated for the furnishing of an Automated Dispatch and Payroll Interface Software System be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.


Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Multisystems, Incorporated for the furnishing of an Automated Dispatch and Payroll Interface Software System.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the RTA Capital Fund (Data Systems Department budget) in the amount of two hundred forty-three thousand seven hundred sixty-one & 00/100 dollars (\$243,761.00).

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to bid Specifications and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1993-88; bonding and insurance requirements, and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
