

RESOLUTION NO. 1994- 62

AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH S & P SOLUTIONS FOR PROJECT MANAGEMENT SERVICES FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF AN ORACLE FMS/MMMIS SYSTEM AT A PRICE OF \$105,110.00 - CAPITAL GRANT OH-90-0068 (100% LOCAL MATCH).

WHEREAS, the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority has entered into an agreement with Oracle Corporation to provide an integrated financial, maintenance, and materials management information software system; and

WHEREAS, the Authority has deemed it necessary to seek technical expertise to ensure the successful management of this complex project; and

WHEREAS, the proposal of S & P Solutions located at 730 SOM Center Road, Suite 100, Cleveland, Ohio 44143 to provide project management services for the implementation of an Oracle FMS/MMMIS System was received on March 25, 1994; and

WHEREAS, S & P Solutions submitted a negotiated offer to provide project management services at a price not to exceed one hundred five thousand one hundred ten & 00/100 dollars (\$105,110.00); and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the negotiated offer of S & P Solutions to be the most advantageous to the Authority, price and all other factors considered, and therefore recommends the acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the offer by S & P Solutions on March 25, 1994 be and is hereby accepted as the most advantageous proposal for project management services for the implementation of an Oracle FMS/MMMIS System at a negotiated price not to exceed one hundred five thousand one hundred ten & 00/100 dollars (\$105,110.00).


Section 2. That said contract shall be consistent with the proposal of S & P Solutions dated March 25, 1994 as amended by negotiations.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of Capital Grant OH-90-0068 (100% Local Match) in an amount not to exceed one hundred five thousand one hundred ten & 00/100 dollars (\$105,110.00).


Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent compliance by the contractor to the negotiated scope of work and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1993-88; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
