AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH VARIOUS INDIVIDUALS FOR THE SALE OF APPROXIMATELY 2,245 USED RAILROAD TIES IN "AS IS" CONDITION FOR A TOTAL PURCHASE PRICE OF ONE THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED TWENTY-EIGHT & 65/100 DOLLARS (\$1,628.65).

WHEREAS, the Power Department has approximately 2,245 used railroad ties which are no longer suitable for rail use; and

WHEREAS, the best interest of the Authority requires the disposition of said ties by competitive bidding; and

WHEREAS, the bids of various individuals for said railroad ties were received on the 28th day of June, 1994; and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bids of herein named individuals to be the highest responsive bids from responsible bidders and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Dale Frehmeyer whose address is 1311 Old Eagle Drive, #111, Brunswick, Ohio 44212 for the purchase of one (1) lot of 100 used railroad ties for a total purchase price of two hundred seventy-five & 00/100 dollars (\$275.00) be and the same is hereby accepted as the highest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

Section 2. That the bid of John Rose whose address is 1901 Train Avenue, Cleveland, Ohio 44113 for the purchase of twenty (20) lots of 100 each @ \$65.00, for a total price of one thousand three hundred & 00/100 dollars (\$1,300.00) be and the same is hereby accepted as the highest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

Section 3. That the bid of Surplus by George located at 6750 Brookpark Road, Cleveland, Ohio 44129 for the purchase of the remaining 1.45 lots @ \$37.00 per lot of 100, for a total price of fifty-three and & 65/100 dollars (\$53.65) be and the same is hereby accepted as the highest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

Section 4. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into contracts with the above listed individuals for the sale of approximately 2,245 used railroad ties as described on such terms as are appropriate for the protection of the interest of the Authority.

Section 5. That the proceeds of said sale in the amount of one thousand six hundred twenty-eight & 65/100 dollars (\$1,628.65) be deposited into the General Fund.

Section 6. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
