

RESOLUTION NO. 1995-131

AUTHORIZING CONTRACT #95081 WITH DELTA RAILROAD CONSTRUCTION, INC. FOR THE FURNISHING OF TRACK BALLAST IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED FORTY-FIVE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED & 00/100 DOLLARS (\$45,900.00 - RTA CAPITAL FUND) POWER DEPARTMENT BUDGET.

WHEREAS, the bid of Delta Railroad Construction, Inc., located at 2648 West Prospect Road, Ashtabula, Ohio, 44044 for the furnishing of track ballast was received on the 28th of August, 1995, for a price set forth in said bid of forty-five thousand nine hundred & 00/100 dollars (\$45,900.00); and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of Delta Railroad Construction, Inc. to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Delta Railroad Construction, Inc. received on August 28, 1995 be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.


Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with the Delta Railroad Construction, Inc. for the furnishing of track ballast, as specified.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the RTA Capital Fund in an amount not-to-exceed forty-five thousand nine hundred & 00/100 dollars (\$45,900.00).

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the Delta Railroad Construction, Inc. with the terms of the contract, compliance to the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1993-88, the specifications and addenda, if any; and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
