

RESOLUTION NO. 1996-49

AUTHORIZING A SOLE SOURCE CONTRACT WITH BRUNSWICK FIRE PROTECTION SYSTEMS CO. FOR THE FURNISHING OF PROJECT 5.94 - INSTALLATION OF GLYCOL IN THE GATEWAY ACCESSWAY SPRINKLER SYSTEM \$41,886.62 - RTA CAPITAL FUND

WHEREAS, on January 5, 1996, bids for the furnishing and installation of glycol in the Gateway Accessway sprinkler system were solicited; and

WHEREAS, at 12:00 Noon on January 31, 1996, the date and time established for the receipt of such bids, no bids were received; and

WHEREAS, after reasonable inquiry, it was determined that no competitive bids were available for these services; and

WHEREAS, ORC 306.43 (H) (2) allows sole source procurement when the competitive process does not result in a bid capable of award; and

WHEREAS, Brunswick Fire Protection Systems Co. submitted an offer March 29, 1996 to provide the needed services at a price of forty-one thousand eight hundred eighty-six & 62/100 dollars (\$41,886.62).

WHEREAS, the General Manager has determined acceptance of the offer of Brunswick Fire Protection Systems Co., to be in the best interest of the Authority.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the offer of Brunswick Fire Protection Systems Co., dated March 29, 1996, be accepted as in the best interest of the Authority.

Section 2. That the General Manager be and is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Brunswick Fire Protection Systems Co. for the furnishing of Project 5.94 - Installation of Glycol in the Gateway Accessway Sprinkler System.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the RTA Capital Fund in an amount of forty-one thousand eight hundred eighty-six & 62/100 dollars (\$41,886.62).

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1993-88; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.
