AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO INCREASE THE PRICE OF THE CONTRACT WITH MARTIN BOYLE FOR THE DESIGN, FABRICATION, AND INSTALLATION OF ART AT THE SETTLER'S LANDING STATION AT A PRICE OF \$15,000.00 FOR A TOTAL CONTRACT PRICE OF \$30,000.00 - RTA CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND - 100% LOCAL FUNDS

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees, By Resolution 1991-172 established the Arts-in-Transit program for the purpose of implementing a program to integrate art into various public transit facilities; and

WHEREAS, a contract was awarded to Martin Boyle of 2008 E.125th Street, #3, Cleveland, Ohio 44106, to design, fabricate and install art at the Settler's Landing Station at a price of fifteen thousand & 00/100 dollars (\$15,000.00) under the General Manager's delegated authority; and

WHEREAS, an additional three (3) windscreens have been added to the project at a price of fifteen thousand & 00/100 dollars (\$15,000.00); and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the offer of Martin Boyle, as modified by negotiations for design, fabrication, and installation of additional art at the Settler's Landing Station be and is hereby accepted as the most advantageous for the Authority.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to amend the contract with Martin Boyle for the furnishing of additional art services necessary to complete the design, fabrication and installation of art at the Settler's Landing Station at a price of fifteen thousand & 00/100 dollars (\$15,000.00) for a total contract price of thirty thousand and 00/100 dollars(30,000.00).

Section 3. That this amendment shall be payable from the RTA Capital Improvement Fund, in the amount of fifteen thousand & 00/100 dollars (\$15,000.00).

Section 4. That all other terms and conditions of the contract shall remain unchanged.
