## RESOLUTION NO. 2001-134

AUTHORIZING CONTRACT 2001-072 WITH INTERMEDIA COMMUNICATIONS TO PROVIDE INTERNET SERVICE TO THE AUTHORITY FOR A PERIOD OF THREE YEARS, WITH AN OPTION FOR TWO ADDITIONAL ONE-YEAR TERMS, AT A PRICE NOT TO EXCEED \$90,388.00, GENERAL FUND, INFORMATION SYSTEMS DEPARTMENT BUDGET

WHEREAS, the Authority identified a need to contract with an Internet Service Provider; and

WHEREAS, the proposal of Intermedia Communications, located at 5080 Spectrum Drive, Suite 500E, Addison, TX 75001 for the furnishing of Internet Service for the Authority, was received on August 10, 2001; and

WHEREAS, after negotiations, a total price not to exceed ninety thousand, three hundred, eighty-eight and 00/100 dollars (\$90,388.00) for the base three year period was agreed upon; and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the offer of Intermedia Communications to be the most advantageous to the Authority, cost and all other factors considered.

NOW, therefore, be it resolved by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

- Section 1. That the offer of Intermedia Communications, as negotiated, for the furnishing of Internet Service is hereby accepted as the most advantageous to the Authority, cost and all other factors considered.
- Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Intermedia Communications to furnish Internet Service for the Authority for a period of three years, with an option for two additional one-year terms.
- Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the General Fund Information Systems Department Budget, in an amount not to exceed ninety thousand, three hundred, eighty-eight and 00/100 dollars (\$90,388.00) for the base three year period and twenty-nine thousand, seven hundred, ninety six and 00/100 dollars (\$29,796.00) for each of the two option year periods, contingent upon funding available for said options.
- Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and in obligation of the Authority, contingent upon appropriations for future contract years, and upon, compliance by the contractor to the specification and addenda, if any; the affirmative action plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 2001-064; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.
